## **Resolution 1**

## Issue:

A program needs to be established that allows retiring farms a place to get market value for their land while also allowing new farmers, young farmers, or those wishing to expand an opportunity to either lease, lease to own or buy that land. Whereas the population of PEI continues to rise, urban sprawl continues to take farmland out of production

**Therefore be it resolved** that the PEI Federation of Agriculture lobby the Provincial Government to establish a land bank program in order to create opportunity for young farmers, new entrants and people wishing to expand so our farmland stays in production.
