



Heather Venenga helps readers answer the following questions:




- Who do I need on my team to get a solid generational farm plan in place?





Elaine Froese is a lifetime farmer, professional speaker, writer and coach who helps farm families work through issues surrounding succession, business and communication.






WHAT IS THE FUTURE OF AMERICAN FAMILY AGRICULTURE?


